- 1. Contact the Jewett City DPU Electric Division at 376-2877 or come in person at 29 School Street in Jewett City, far enough in advance to allow for proper planning by you and us.
- 2. The Jewett City DPU will provide you with the following information:
- Designate the service location.
- Specify the type and character of supply that is available.
- Specify the location and requirements for our meter equipment.
- 3. A request for electric service form must be submitted for any new, changed, removed or temporary service. The request must be made in person at the Light Plant building on School Street.
- 4. An electrical permit must also be obtained from the Griswold Town Hall located on Main Street.
- 5. By CT state law single family home owners can perform electrical work on their own home. Any other residences and/or commercial properties require that the work be done by a CT licensed electrical (E1) contractor only. Unless the homeowner is an E1 licensed electrician, homeowners are not permiteed to cut and tap.
- 6. The Jewett City DPU allows E1 licensed electricians to cut and tap, or use jumpers in the meter socket. This work is to be done only with the expressed written consent of the Jewett City DPU.

Failure to comply with our requirements, applicable codes or orders of an enforcement authority can result in our refusal to energize the service, or in the disconnection of an existing service.
